Transportation Inventory and Analysis


Knowledge of the transportation systems in and around a community is critical for sustainable transportation enhancement planning. Alleman's transportation system includes a US highway, roadways, and waterways.

US Highway 69 is a primary carrier of traffic for vehicles traveling north and south, while the main entrance roads for the community include NE 142nd Avenue and NE 134th Avenue.

The visioning team met with Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) personnel and local officials to identify existing, past, and future transportation-related constraints and opportunities in the Alleman area.

Several transportation-related assets and opportunities identified include a potential recreational area along Fourmile creek, future residential developments, and general growth of the city.


