### Accessibility and Connectivity

It is clearly shown on the Transportation Assets and Barriers Boards that Clarion residents have limited safe access to community resources such as parks and stores. A comprehensive trail and sidewalk plan coupled with small, site specific improvements like signage and pavement markings create better pedestrian circulation. Pedestrian crossing improvements at the railroad track crossing north of Lions Park.

Lions Family Park is one of the only parks on the south side of Highway 3. There are railroad tracks directly north of the park, making it unsafe for pedestrian access. Additionally, vehicular access from the north is non-existent. Warning signage, park signage, pavement markings and a new paved shoulder offer a much safer crossing condition.
