



The Conrad steering committee presented what they learned from the TAB assessment and bioregional boards to the landscape architects.

The committee then identified and communicated goals and values. The goals are based on the information from the assessments. Each committee member also included reasoning for improvements around town and highlighted specific programming needs for the identified areas of concern.

The landscape architects organized programming themes for the city of Conrad using the goals identified by the steering committee. Greater importance was given to the goals that were highlighted in discussion and/or repeated by individuals during the goal setting meeting.
