



#### Lillian Avenue: Existing Sidewalk Conditions



Lillian Avenue runs east-west on the north side of town, allowing access to the elementary school, Dreamland Park, and the ball diamonds. It is designated by the community as an essential route. ## Lillian Avenue: Proposed Sidewalk Conditions (West of Comet Trail)


