



Reunion Park

Enhancements to Reunion Park are designed to complement the existing amenities, turning it into a year-round space for the Conrad community to enjoy. Through both active and performative programming, community members of all ages will find opportunities to engage with features that help responsibly deal with stormwater runoff and attract pollinators and birds. Coming from the northeast off the Comet Trail, a dynamic bioswale of varying native plants helps promote water infiltration, the capturing of stormwater runoff from the nearby parking lot, and improved water quality. Adjacent to the existing basketball court, two pickleball courts and a bike rack provide new sporting opportunities to the community. Mulching the playground area with a similar pattern to the bioswale creates cohesiveness throughout the park. There are opportunities for future park expansion, with nature play elements. Further to the east, a walking circuit is added with more garden plantings to create a space where people will want to frequently revisit.
