
WHAT TYPES OF ENHANCEMENTS ARE IMPORTANT? Mobility, Safety, and Health!

Transportation Enhancement Issues Pedestrian Mobility, Safety, and Health Quality of the Built Environment



Importance of transportation enhancement by type (85 responses)

On a scale of 1 to 5, with 5 being the most important, participants in Dunlap ranked improving accessibility for seniors as most important, with a mean value of 4.09. Other types of transportation enhancements that address pedestrian mobility, health, and safety are also considered important, such as improving areas for night use (4.01), providing more opportunities for physical activity (3.76) and creating safer routes to school (3.78). In terms of quality of the built environment, survey respondents consider creating better neighborhood streetscapes as most important (3.75), followed by enhancing the downtown streetscape (3.67) and enhancing seasonal beauty (3.62).

WHAT DID THEY SAY? Survey Participants Said...



"[I would like a] sidewalk between Hwy 30 and the golf course for people [who] like to bike or walk from town down to Toledo Avenue (L66) for exercise."

"Dunlap needs to have improvements in [its] sidewalk infrastructure. [There are] not enough sidewalks on both sides of the road, and they are poorly maintained and need to be replaced, and curbing along streets."



"Some streets are not well lit and sidewalks are not available."

"So many of the sidewalks in this community are in very sorry condition or no longer exist, so people walk in the streets."
