

Importance of transportation enhancement by type (111 responses)

On a scale of 1 to 5, with 5 being the most important, participants in Emmetsburg ranked creating safer routes to school as most important, both with a mean value of 3.96. Other types of transportation enhancements that address pedestrian mobility, health, and safety are also considered important, such as creating more accessibility for seniors (3.88) and providing more opportunities for physical activity (3.84). In terms of quality of the built environment, survey respondents consider better neighborhood streetscapes as most important (3.65), followed by enhanced seasonal beauty (3.58) and enhanced downtown streetscape (3.55).

WHAT DID THEY SAY?



Survey Participants Said...



"[I feel safe biking] only on the trail. My route on roads is NOT safe due to traffic. I want to bike more than 10 miles."

"I think more elderly would get out...if we had more safe sidewalks in town."





"I think they need to redo all the sidewalks in Emmetsburg on every street, not just Main Street and Broadway Street."

"As the children grow up there is concern of them crossing the heavy traffic of Highway 18. I know there are other mothers who share this same concern. It would be great to have bicycle crossings from south side of Highway 18 to north side of Highway 18."
