

Roundabout Signage

With the installation of a roundabout north of Fairfax along Highway 151 in Cedar Rapids, there is precedent for additional roundabouts within the city. The Bellon Family Farm Master Plan proposes adding two roundabouts along Highway 151 that would have some form of gateway or monumental signage. These roundabouts would be significant as the conduits between the future development of Fairfax and the town's more historic areas. This proposed signage is meant to reflect that relationship and utilizes material within the signage family to create an attractive symbol of the agrarian history of Fairfax with a modern twist. The central silo form, while simplified structurally, is scaled to emulate the existing silos in downtown Fairfax. This feature could be lit at night or have vines intertwined within it to add some more dimension and interest. All elements proposed within the DOT right-of-way will need formal review and approval.
