Concept Plan Overview

The community visioning process provides solutions for areas along transportation corridors where safety, circulation, connectivity, and visual enhancements are desirable. Part of this process is also addressing the accessibility needs of the communities, such as providing safe and accessible pedestrian paths and walkways to connect special places within a community.

The concept plan to the left graphically shows the broad priority areas identified by the Garrison visioning committee. The design team addressed each area during the city's participation in the Iowa's Living Roadways Community Visioning Program.
