

Transportation Mapping

Transportation is an essential component in the overall safety and economic well-being of a community. Providing safe, accessible routes to walk, bike, or drive to various destinations is an important indicator of quality of life. Glidden residents expressed a desire to improve walkability among community destinations through participation in surveys and assessment workshops (see boards 3a & 3b). They also identified Highway 30 as a barrier inhibiting pedestrian access. The design team used this information to explore opportunities for improving connectivity, safety and cohesiveness throughout the community.
