Meeting Summary:

The Hampton Visioning Committee met at the Franklin County ISU Extension building for pre-goal setting. Trees Forever Field Coordinator Jeff Jensen led the group through a review of the survey that was conducted in town. Hampton had a good response rate and the feedback provided will help to inform the committee and the L.A.'s when it comes to project prioritization and design. After working through the survey results, the group broke into smaller groups to review the various transportation assets and barriers boards.

After everyone had an opportunity to familiarize themselves, each group reported out on things that stood out to them. The matrix garnered a lot of discussion and was great to put all that information into context. The committee pulled out various themes from the transportation assets and barriers boards, the focus group map, and the survey; shown below:

- Trails
 - Olive to Beeds
 - Cemetery
 - Spurs
 - Trailheads
- Entryway
 - Non-inviting
 - Amenities/Accents
- Parks
- Main St.
 - Amenities
 - Spruce it up
- Courthouse space
 - Includes Band Shell Park

Field Coordinator Jensen outlined how the goal setting meeting would go on June 13th. The idea of goal setting is to first bring the L.A.'s up to speed on the different assessments that have taken place. Jeff will prepare talking points from the discussion that was generated from this meeting and provide them as a guide for the goal setting.

The second objective of goal setting is to brainstorm potential project ideas and then prioritize them; the L.A.'s will facilitate this.

Before adjourning we discussed planning and promotion for goal setting and the design workshop. Jeff encouraged the committee to spread the word to other committee members since goal setting is a very important meeting where we need lots of participation. It will be held Monday, June 13th at 5:00 at the Franklin County ISU Extension building.

Goal setting is scheduled for the next day on Tuesday, June 14th starting at 9:00 a.m. running through 4:30 at the extension building. Then the design team will move to Band Shell Park for Tuesdays in the Park where we'll have the tent set up and be taking feedback from attendees. Committee members should be present to greet attendees and help to explain to them what the visioning committee has been up to for the last several months.

A flier has been made up in both English and Spanish, along with a press release. Jeff also prepared talking points for Susan for the radio and anyone else can use them as well. Jeff encouraged committee members to use their social media contacts to spread the word about coming to the design workshop to provide feedback. Spreading the word among other organization or networks committee members belong to is important as well.
