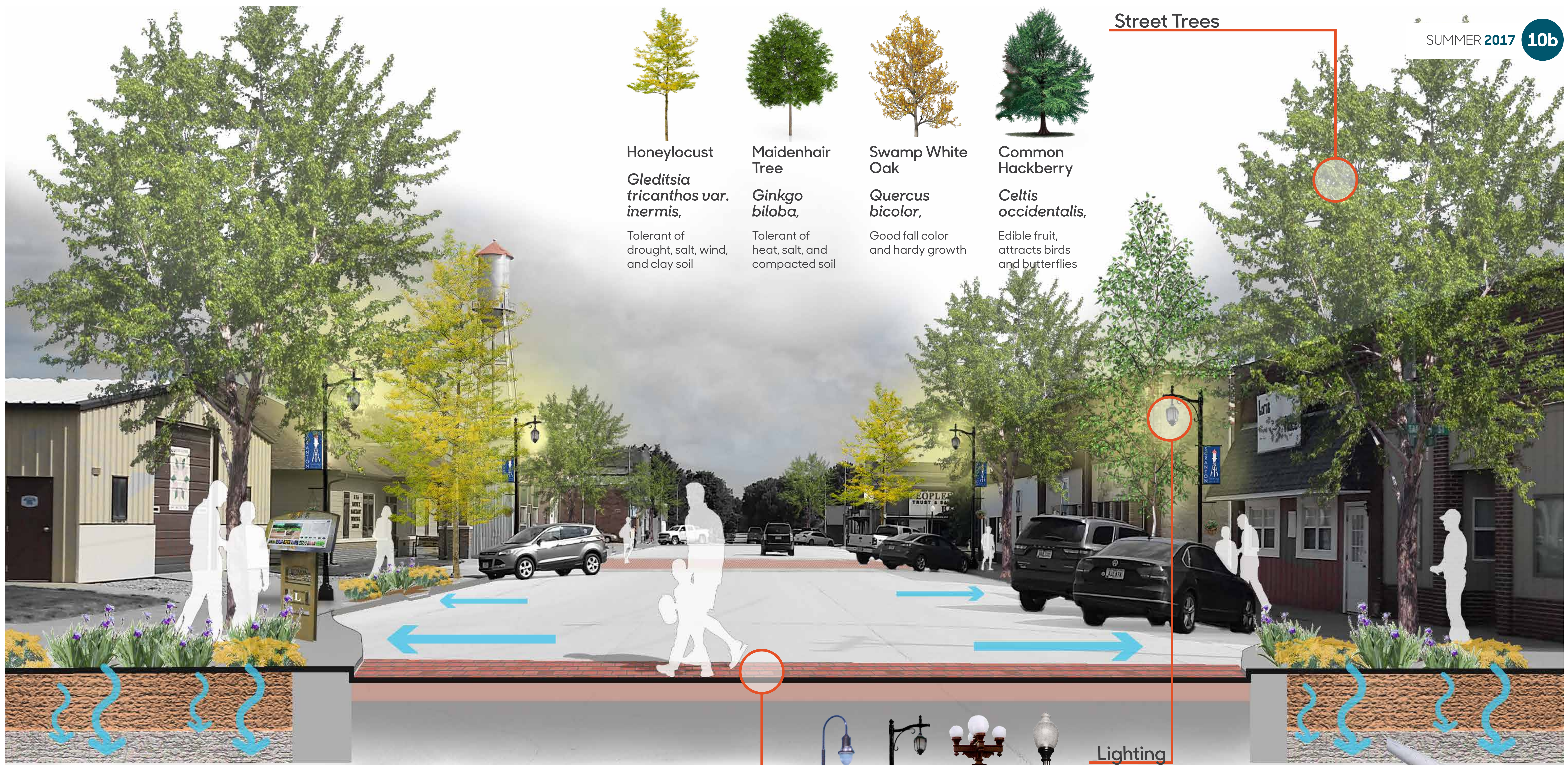






Street Trees

**Honeylocust**  
*Gleditsia tricanthos var. inermis*  
 Tolerant of drought, salt, wind, and clay soil
-   
**Maidenhair Tree**  
*Ginkgo biloba*  
 Tolerant of heat, salt, and compacted soil
-   
**Swamp White Oak**  
*Quercus bicolor*  
 Good fall color and hardy growth
-   
**Common Hackberry**  
*Celtis occidentalis*  
 Edible fruit, attracts birds and butterflies

**Asphalt**  
 \$6-10 per sq. ft.\*  
 High maintenance, easy to repair
-   
**Brick**  
 \$15-25 per sq. ft.\*  
 Regular maintenance, historic look
-   
**Concrete**  
 \$6-12 per sq. ft.\*  
 Low maintenance, cracks under extreme pressure
-   
**Stamped Concrete**  
 \$8-15 per sq. ft.\*  
 Low maintenance, difficult or expensive repairs
