Danny Anderson Memorial Field and Park

Danny Anderson Memorial Field and Park is a triangular parcel of Residents and the steering committee are excited about the land that has a nice Little League baseball field with a backstop, proposed southern expansion of the park, which would include team dugouts, and a maintenance shed.
